Minutes of August 12th, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District #47 was called to order by Commissioner Styles at 7:19pm. Commissioner Beniasch made a motion to approve the previous months minutes. Commissioner Bruce seconded the motion.

Financial Report: Balance of funds on August 12th, 2025

Expense Fund: \$429,726.78-\$115,303.93 (July Expense Vouchers)=\$**314,422.85**

GO Bond Fund: \$1,187.56

Vouchers: The July Expense fund vouchers were reviewed. Commissioner Bruce made a motion to approve payment of vouchers 2025249 through 2025287. Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion, and the July Expense fund vouchers were signed for \$115,303.93.

Chief's Report:

- Calls: 75 calls to date
- Still working on SOP/SOG's revision-no updates
- Segale-no update, still "in-review"
- Ashley has the radios, batteries, SCBA packs, and bottles entered for inventory.
- Maintenance is on-going on the trucks. 2 trucks are done. Engine 89 has been in for a while, and probably will be in for a while with a big bill. Problem with the emergency lights.
- Did receive the data door lock module, haven't tried it out yet.
- New air compressor has been delivered and installed. Had to do an update on the wiring. That was \$1350 plus tax, no bill yet for that.
- Physicals-only Multicare replied back to Shannon. Chief said lets just go with them. Shannon will work on getting that started.

Unfinished Business:

1. Levy Lift-We submitted the materials for the November ballot.
2. Volunteer point system/Officer stipend pay-Commissioner Styles made an analysis of this information. Some technical issues so not able to present tonight.
3. Signage project: Still on-going
4. We started recording our meetings mid-year last year. Previous Commissioner Hickey had those recordings on his camera. We never got those recordings. They are legally our property and are legal records. We'll need to send a certificated letter to Steve asking for the recordings. We need the recordings so that there are public records that are out there that we're not in possession of. Commissioner Styles will send a certified letter to previous Commissioner Hickey. (Discussion of live stream future meetings, to table for another time)-**No response (yet)**. Commissioner Styles will ask Snure about this.
5. Maple Valley Lawn & Maintenance-no good quotes from other companies. (too small of a job for larger companies). Volunteers will present a bid next month for this service.
6. Thrive Fitness-no other gyms in the area that are open 24 hours, so we'll stay with Thrive Fitness.

New Business:

1. Snure made some changes to the press release for the on-going investigation. Snure would like to talk to Commissioners about the press release before releasing. Discussion was do we have a meeting with all commissioners and Snure or just one commissioner meet with Snure?? It was determined that Commissioner Styles will contact Snure.
