Minutes of June 15th, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of King County Fire Protection District #47 was called to order by Commissioner Freitag at 7:05pm. Commissioner Beniasch made a motion to approve the previous months minutes. Commissioner Freitag seconded the motion.

Secretary Report: Annual audit that was due on May 30th, 2026 is complete.

Financial Report: Balance of funds on June 15th, 2026

Expense Fund: \$500,328.46-\$40,166.48 (May Expense Vouchers)=\$**460,161.98**

GO Bond Fund: \$1,322.52

Vouchers: The May Expense fund vouchers were reviewed. Commissioner Freitag made a motion to approve payment of vouchers. Commissioner Beniasch seconded the motion, and the May Expense fund vouchers were signed for \$40,166.48. Truck Payment check included (\$25k).

- Documents are complete for air trailer-waiting for them to reply to an email
- Working on ordering bunker gear (4 sets) that was in the budget
- Starlink is increasing to \$175 a month
- We have two new generators

Unfinished Business:

1. Levy Lift- Everything submitted to the county and we're good to go. It will be on the August ballot. 😊 Volunteers are going to set up the Town Hall. July 11th is the date it should be happening...
2. New apparatus to replace T89. Commissioner Bruce talked to Kim last week as there are still some outstanding questions. No truck is currently available. Trucks are 16-19 months out. Last payment of E88 is being made this month. Need more info from MK/Kim. By the August meeting we should know if the Levy Lift passes. The terms are usually that the loan is a 10 year loan, one annual payment for ten years.
